April Board Meeting

The Board of Professional Conduct met on April 7 and approved [eight case reports](#). The reports were filed with the Supreme Court the afternoon of April 7, and we are awaiting the issuance of show-cause orders from the Court. The next Board meeting is June 9.

The Board has 22 pending cases, five of which are awaiting reports and 11 of which are scheduled for hearing. Three cases are stayed, and three are awaiting answers. The Board has opened just six new cases this year.

Probable Cause Deadlines

The next two probable cause deadlines are April 28 and May 26. New complaints with probable cause waivers may be submitted through the probable cause e-Filing portal at any time.

Hearing Room Upgrades at the Moyer Judicial Center

The hearing room technology renovations referenced in my February update have been completed and used in three disciplinary hearings thus far. Added to the relator/respondents' counsel page Board's website is a [description of the new equipment and instructions for its use](#). Disciplinary Counsel and the Board are working on a short training video that will be added to the website when it is completed.
